There are two main ways to format an in-text citation: Parenthetical citation or Narrative citation. Parenthetical citation: Put all the citation information at the end of the sentence: Narrative citation: Include some of the citation information as part of the sentence: Each source cited in-text must also be listed in your References list.

There is no need to note that you are quoting a source within the source as part of this reference. When citing quoted material in the body of your text, mention the original source in the sentence and the secondary source in a parenthetical citation at the end of the line. For example:

Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

In-text Citation - APA Quick Citation Guide - Library ...

Add a citation for both the work that the citation is coming from and the source of the original text in both APA and MLA formats. For the original source, add "Quoted in (author's name of the citing work)" to the end of the citation to show where the information came from.

To cite a source you found in another source, state the original author (direct source) within your sentence and state "qtd. in" followed by the last name and year of the secondary source. For example: According to Smith, students need faculty and staff support to succeed (qtd. in Brown).

Always capitalize proper nouns, including author names and initials: D. Jones. If you refer to the title of a source within your paper, capitalize all words that are four letters long or greater...

Citing a web page is very similar to citing a website except the title of the page is added in italics: Author surname(s), initial(s). (Year of publishing). Title of page [Online]. Title of site. Available at: URL (Accessed: day month year) Web Page Example. Thomson, M. (2017). APA citation [Online]. How and when to reference.

Start your Works Cited entry with the author's name, if provided. If an individual author is listed for the web page you want to cite, type their last name first, followed by a comma, then their first name. Place a period at the end of the name.

Give the secondary source in the reference list; in text, name the original work and give a citation for the secondary source. For example, if Allport's work is cited in Nicholson and you did not read Allport's work, list the Nicholson reference in the reference list. In the text, use the following citation:

If you cite from different volumes of a multivolume work, always include the volume number followed by a colon. Put a space after the colon, then provide the page number (s). (If you only cite from one volume, provide only the page number in parentheses.)... as Quintilian wrote in Institutio Oratoria (1: 14-17).

How you cite a working within your document varies depending on your writing style, whether you are quoting your source directly, and the type of source you are quoting. When using APA format, follow the author, date method of in-text citation.

APA (American Psychological Association) - Citation Guide ...

To do this, cite BOTH the original and secondary source through in-text citation within the paper, but cite ONLY the secondary source in your reference list at the end of the paper. Proper APA format depends on how the original source appears in the secondary source. In both cases, you must use the phrase "as cited in" to indicate the author(s) ...

Include the in-text citation from the original source within the text of your quotation Include the book, article or other resource you're actually reading/working with on your reference list Do not add the reference page entry for the citation within your quotation Citation within another article

APA Referencing Basics: In-Text Citation In-text references must be included following the use of a quote or paraphrase taken from another piece of work. In-text citations are citations within the main body of the text and refer to a direct quote or paraphrase. They correspond to a reference in the main reference list.

Start your Works Cited entry with the author of the essay. Type the last name of the author of the essay first, followed by a comma. Then, type the first name of the author of the essay, followed by a period.

If you use a quotation from an author, summarize or paraphrase another person's ideas or research, you must identify (cite) the source of that information within the body of your paper. These citations are called parenthetical or in-text citations because the citation may be in parentheses at the end of the quotation or paraphrase.
